The seven day trip was made in White Motor Company coaches with Bender bodies, of the parlor car variety. Each person had an individual chair upholstered in finest mobilir and trimmed in leather. The tour that year included 6 nights hotel, all the sight-secing, all the meals, tips and entertainment and cost the fantahidous price of \$87.50 per person!

In the early 1950's the Canton AAA started its own motorcoach tours and since that time has carried many thousands of travelers to all corners of the United States and Canada.

In these days of gasoline shortages and expensive vars, this mode of travel has proved to be a boon to the person with a touch of the wanderlust and a lot of curiosity?
